- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 49.278, Water Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) This subchapter does not apply to:
- 9 (1) equipment, materials, or machinery purchased by
- 10 the district at an auction that is open to the public;
- 11 (2) contracts for personal or professional services or
- 12 for a utility service operator;
- 13 (3) contracts made by a district engaged in the
- 14 distribution and sale of electric energy to the public;
- 15 (4) contracts for services or property for which there
- 16 is only one source or for which it is otherwise impracticable to
- 17 obtain competition; [or]
- 18 (5) high technology procurements; or
- 19 <u>(6)</u> contracts for services related to compliance with
- 20 a state or federal construction stormwater requirement, including
- 21 the acquisition of permits, the construction, repair, and removal
- of temporary erosion control devices, the cleaning of silt and
- 23 <u>debris</u> from streets and storm sewers, the monitoring of
- 24 construction sites, and the preparation and filing of all required
