13	(3) contracts made by a district engaged in the
14	distribution and sale of electric energy to the public;
15	(4) contracts for services or property for which there
16	is only one source or for which it is otherwise impracticable to
17	obtain competition; [or]
18	(5) high technology procurements; or
19	(6) contracts for services related to compliance with
20	a state or federal construction stormwater requirement, including
21	the acquisition of permits, the construction, repair, and removal
22	of temporary erosion control devices, the cleaning of silt and
23	debris from streets and storm sewers, the monitoring of
24	construction sites, and the preparation and filing of all required

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
