## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the assessment of the need and demand for adult

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.252, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 29.252. STATE ROLE IN ADULT AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION.
- 8 (a) The agency shall:
- 9 (1) provide adequate staffing to develop, administer,
- 10 and support a comprehensive statewide adult education program and
- 11 coordinate related federal and state programs for education and
- 12 training of adults;
- 13 (2) develop, implement, and regulate a comprehensive
- 14 statewide program for community level education services to meet
- 15 the special needs of adults;
- 16 (3) develop the mechanism and guidelines for
- 17 coordination of comprehensive adult education and related skill
- 18 training services for adults with other agencies, both public and
- 19 private, in planning, developing, and implementing related
- 20 programs, including community education programs;
- 21 (4) administer all state and federal funds for adult
- 22 education and related skill training in this state, except in
- 23 programs for which another entity is specifically authorized to do
- 24 so under other law;

- 1 (5) prescribe and administer standards and
- 2 accrediting policies for adult education;
- 3 (6) prescribe and administer rules for teacher
- 4 certification for adult education;
- 5 (7) accept and administer grants, gifts, services, and
- 6 funds from available sources for use in adult education; [and]
- 7 (8) adopt or develop and administer a standardized
- 8 assessment mechanism for assessing all adult education program
- 9 participants who need literacy instruction, adult basic education,
- 10 or secondary education leading to an adult high school diploma or
- 11 the equivalent; and
- 12 (9) develop and administer a mechanism for measuring
- 13 the need and demand for adult education programs in this state and
- 14 report the need and demand assessed by the mechanism to the
- 15 legislature on an annual basis.
- 16 (b) The assessment mechanism prescribed under Subsection
- 17 (a)(8) must include an initial basic skills screening instrument
- 18 and must provide comprehensive information concerning baseline
- 19 student skills before and student progress after participation in
- 20 an adult education program.
- 21 (c) The mechanism prescribed under Subsection (a)(9) shall
- 22 <u>include a measurement of the number of individuals placed on wait</u>
- 23 <u>lists for adult education programs.</u>
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2003, the Texas
- 25 Education Agency shall complete development of the mechanism for
- 26 measuring the need and demand for adult education programs in this
- 27 state prescribed under Section 29.252, Education Code, as amended
