A representative of a cemetery 12 organization or a funeral establishment may use a name or date 13 released under this subsection only for the purpose of inscribing 14 15 the name or date on a grave marker.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
