- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter G, Chapter 231, Local
- 5 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 SUBCHAPTER G. ZONING AROUND LAKE ALAN HENRY, LAKE COOPER, [AND]
- 7 POST LAKE, AND LAKE RALPH HALL
- 8 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 231.131, Local
- 9 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) The legislature finds that:
- 11 (1) the areas that surround Lake Alan Henry, Lake
- 12 Cooper, Lake Ralph Hall, and Post Lake are or will be frequented for
- 13 recreational purposes by residents from every part of the state;
- 14 (2) orderly development and use of the area is of
- 15 concern to the entire state; and
- 16 (3) buildings in the area that will be frequented for
- 17 resort or recreational purposes will tend to become congested and
- 18 to be used in ways that interfere with the proper use of the area as
- 19 a place of recreation to the detriment of the public health, safety,
- 20 morals, and general welfare.
- 21 SECTION 3. Subsection (a), Section 231.132, Local
- 22 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) This subchapter applies to:
- 24 (1) those parts of Garza County located within one

- 1 mile of the high water marks established for Lake Alan Henry and
- 2 Post Lake except land located in Garza County and owned by the White
- 3 River Municipal Water District;
- 4 (2) those parts of Kent County located within one mile
- of the high water marks established for Lake Alan Henry; [and]
- 6 (3) the area within 10,000 feet of where the shoreline
- 7 of Lake Cooper would be if the lake were filled to its storage
- 8 capacity; and
- 9 (4) the area within 5,000 feet of where the shoreline
- of Lake Ralph Hall would be if the lake were filled to its storage
- 11 capacity.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
