- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. (a) Section 24.480, Government Code, is 5 repealed.
- 6 (b) The 334th District Court of Harris County is abolished 7 on the effective date of this Act, and the judge of that court shall 8 transfer each case that is pending in the court on that date to a
- 9 district court in the county with jurisdiction over the case.
- 10 (c) When a case is transferred as provided by Subsection (b)
- 12 other obligations issued from the transferring court are returnable

of this section, all processes, writs, bonds, recognizances, or

taken in and for a court from which a case is transferred, and all

- 13 to the court to which the case is transferred as if originally
- issued by that court. The obligees on all bonds and recognizances
- 16 witnesses summoned to appear in a court from which a case is
- 17 transferred, are required to appear before the court to which a case
- 18 is transferred as if originally required to appear before that
- 19 court.

- SECTION 2. Chapter 24, Government Code, is amended by
- 21 adding Section 24.480 to read as follows:
- Sec. 24.480. 334TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (HARRIS COUNTY).
- 23 (a) The 334th Judicial District is composed of Harris County.
- 24 (b) The 334th District Court shall give preference to civil

1 matters.

- 2 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), this
- 3 Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of
- 4 all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39,
- 5 Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the
- 6 vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect
- 7 September 1, 2003.
- 8 (b) Section 24.480, Government Code, as added by Section 2
- 9 of this Act, takes effect and the 334th Judicial District is created
- 10 September 1, 2005.
