S.B. No. 1781

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to the supplemental salaries of judges of the district  
3 courts having jurisdiction in certain counties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 32.093, Government Code,  
6 is amended to read as follows:

7 (a) The Commissioners Court of Grimes County may pay the  
8 judges of the district courts having jurisdiction in the county an  
9 annual supplemental salary [~~not to exceed \$1,200~~] for judicial and  
10 administrative services.

11 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 32.157, Government Code,  
12 is amended to read as follows:

13 (a) The Commissioners Court of Madison County may pay the  
14 judges of the district courts having jurisdiction in the county an  
15 annual supplemental salary [~~not to exceed \$1,200~~] for judicial and  
16 administrative services.

17 SECTION 3. Subsection (a), Section 32.236, Government Code,  
18 is amended to read as follows:

19 (a) The Commissioners Court of Walker County may pay the  
20 judges of the district courts having jurisdiction in the county an  
21 annual supplemental salary [~~not to exceed \$1,200~~] for judicial and  
22 administrative services.

23 SECTION 4. Subsection (d), Section 32.093, Subsection (d),  
24 Section 32.145, Subsection (d), Section 32.157, and Subsection (d),

1 Section 32.236, Government Code, are repealed.

2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
6 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
