- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 39.202(k), Utilities Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (k) Following the true-up proceedings conducted under
- 7 Section 39.262, the commission may adjust the price to beat to
- 8 reflect the credit devised under Section 39.262(e).
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 389.202(1), Utilities Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (1) The commission may not adjust the fuel factor
- 12 established under Subsection (b) except pursuant to the following
- 13 <u>circumstances:</u>
- 14 (1) An an affiliated retail electric provider may
- 15 request that the commission adjust increase the fuel factor
- 16 established under Subsection (b) not more than twice a year if the
- 17 affiliated retail electric provider demonstrates that the existing
- 18 fuel factor does not adequately reflect significant changes in the
- 19 market price of natural gas and purchased energy used to serve
- 20 retail customers; or
- 21 (2) <u>an affiliated retail electric provided</u>, <u>a</u>
- 22 regulatory authority under Chapter 33, the Office of Public Utility
- 23 Counsel, or the Commission may request that the existing fuel
- 24 factor be decreased if the requesting party demonstrates that the

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- 1 existing fuel factor does not adequately reflect significant
- 2 changes in the market price of natural gas and purchased energy used
- 3 <u>to serve retail customers.</u>
- 4 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 5 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 6 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 7 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 8 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
