- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 841.146, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) In an amount not to exceed \$2,500 [\$1,600], the state
- 8 shall pay the costs of a civil commitment proceeding conducted
- 9 under Subchapter D. For any civil commitment proceeding conducted
- 10 under this chapter, the state shall pay the costs of state or
- 11 appointed counsel or experts and the costs of the person's
- 12 outpatient treatment and supervision.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
