Notwithstanding any other law, the person performing the procedure or test shall make the test results 20 available to the local health authority, and the local health 21 22 authority shall notify the peace officer of the test result. The state may not use the fact that a medical procedure or test was 23 24 performed on a person under this article, or use the results of the
