- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 8, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 8.008 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 8.008. APPLICABILITY OF LAWS RELATING TO CONFLICT OF
- 8 INTEREST. (a) A member of the board of directors and the executive
- 9 director of a regional education service center are each considered
- 10 to be a local public official for purposes of Chapter 171, Local
- 11 Government Code. For purposes of that chapter a member of the board
- of directors and the executive director of a regional education
- 13 service center are each considered to have a substantial interest
- 14 in a business entity if a person related to the member or the
- 15 executive director in the third degree by consanguinity or
- affinity, as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, has a
- 17 substantial interest in the business entity under Section 171.002,
- 18 Local Government Code.
- 19 (b) A regional education service center is considered to be
- 20 <u>a political subdivision for purposes of Section 131.903, Local</u>
- 21 Government Code.
- (c) To the extent consistent with this section, if a law
- 23 described by this section applies to a school district or the board
- 24 of trustees of a school district, the law applies to a regional

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- 1 education service center and the board of directors and executive
- 2 <u>director of a regional education service center.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
