1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to naming the school of pharmacy at Texas A&M
1-10 University--Kingsville and its physical facility after Irma
1-11 Rangel.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 87.303, Education Code,
1-14 is amended to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 87.303. IRMA RANGEL SCHOOL OF PHARMACY.

1-16 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 87.303, Education Code,
1-17 is amended to read as follows:

1-18 (a) The board of regents of The Texas A&M University System
1-19 may establish and maintain a school of pharmacy as a professional
1-20 school of Texas A&M University--Kingsville. The school shall be
1-21 known as the Irma Rangel School of Pharmacy, and the primary
1-22 building in which the school is operated must include "Irma Rangel"
1-23 in its official name.

1-24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
