A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the election of directors and validation of acts of the
- 3 governing board of the Real-Edwards Conservation and Reclamation
- 4 District.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 11, Chapter 341, Acts of
- 7 the 56th Legislature, Regular Session, 1959, is amended to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) There shall be held in the District on the first Tuesday
- 10 after the first Monday in November [Saturday of May] in each
- 11 even-numbered year an election within the District for the
- 12 selection of Directors to succeed those whose terms expire on said
- 13 date. Such election shall be held in such voting boxes as are
- 14 designated by the Board of Directors, and notice of such election
- shall be given by the Secretary of the Board of Directors by posting
- in three (3) public places within the District a copy of the order
- 17 of the Board of Directors directing the time and places of holding
- 18 the election. No person shall be selected a Director unless he be
- 19 above the age of twenty-one (21) years and a resident within the
- 20 territorial limits of the District.
- 21 SECTION 2. (a) The following actions of the Real-Edwards
- 22 Conservation and Reclamation District are validated and confirmed
- 23 as if the actions had been done as authorized by law:
- 24 (1) all acts and governmental proceedings of the

- 1 district taken before the effective date of this Act; and
- 2 (2) the election or appointment of directors or other
- 3 officials of the district who took office before the effective date
- 4 of this Act.
- 5 (b) This Act does not apply to:
- 6 (1) an act or proceeding that was void at the time it
- 7 occurred;
- 8 (2) an act or proceeding that, under a statute of this
- 9 state or the United States, was a misdemeanor or felony at the time
- 10 the act or proceeding occurred;
- 11 (3) a rule that, at the time it was passed, was
- 12 preempted by a statute of this state or the United States; or
- 13 (4) a matter that on the effective date of this Act:
- 14 (A) is involved in litigation if the litigation
- 15 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final
- 16 judgment of a court; or
- 17 (B) has been held invalid by a final judgment of a
- 18 court.
- 19 SECTION 3. (a) A member of the board of directors of the
- 20 Real-Edwards Conservation and Reclamation District serving on the
- 21 effective date of this Act shall continue in office until the
- 22 member's successor, elected at the election held November 2, 2004,
- 23 qualifies for office.
- (b) At the election held November 2, 2004, nine directors
- 25 shall be elected to the board. The nine directors elected shall
- 26 draw lots to determine which four directors serve two-year terms
- 27 and which five directors serve four-year terms beginning January 1

- 1 following the election.
- 2 (c) Directors elected at the election held November 7, 2006,
- 3 and in successive even-numbered years as provided by Section 11,
- 4 Chapter 341, Acts of the 56th Legislature, Regular Session, 1959,
- 5 as amended by this Act, serve four-year terms beginning January 1
- 6 following the election.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
