A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the members of the boards of regents of The University
- 3 of Texas System and The Texas A&M University System.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 65.12, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 65.12. QUALIFICATIONS; TERMS. (a) Each member of the
- 8 board must [shall] be a qualified voter[; and the members shall be
- 9 selected from different portions of the state]. The members hold
- 10 office for staggered terms of six years, with the terms of three
- 11 members expiring February 1 of each odd-numbered year [years].
- 12 (b) The governor shall appoint three members of the board to
- 13 represent the state at large and one member to represent each of the
- 14 regions described by Section 65.121.
- (c) A member of the board appointed under Subsection (b) to
- 16 represent a region must have resided in the region for the two years
- 17 preceding the date of the member's appointment and must continue to
- 18 reside in the region during the member's term.

- SECTION 5. (a) The changes in law made by this Act in the
- 21 qualifications of members of the board of regents of The University
- of Texas System and the board of regents of The Texas A&M University
- 23 System do not affect the entitlement of a member serving on either
- 24 board immediately before the effective date of this Act to continue
- 25 to serve for the remainder of the member's term. The changes in law
- 26 apply only to a member appointed on or after the effective date of
- 27 this Act. This Act does not prohibit a person who is a member of

- 1 either board on the effective date of this Act from being
- 2 reappointed to the board if the person has the qualifications
- 3 required for a member under Section 65.12 or 85.12, Education Code,
- 4 as applicable, as amended by this Act.
- 5 (b) As the terms of members of the boards of regents expire
- 6 or as vacancies occur on the boards, the governor shall make
- 7 appointments to each board to achieve, as soon as possible, the
- 8 applicable membership plan prescribed by Section 65.12 or 85.12,
- 9 Education Code, as amended by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
