- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 5, Chapter 1330, Acts of
- 6 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) The district by rule may require a person to obtain a
- 9 permit from the district for the transfer of groundwater out of the
- 10 district consistent with Section 36.122, Water Code, and may
- 11 regulate the terms on which a permit holder under those rules may
- 12 conduct such a transfer. A retail public utility as defined by
- 13 Section 13.002, Water Code, is not required to obtain a permit to
- 14 transfer groundwater out of the district if:
- 15 (1) the source of the water is one or more wells
- 16 located within the district; and
- 17 (2) the water is used by the retail public utility to
- 18 provide retail water utility service, as defined by Section 13.002,
- 19 Water Code, in a service area located in a county adjacent to the
- 20 district.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
