## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to permit requirements for groundwater transfers out of
3	Pineywoods Groundwater Conservation District.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 5(b), Chapter 1330, Acts of the 77th
6	Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
7	(b) The district by rule may require a person to obtain a
8	permit from the district for the transfer of groundwater out of the
9	district consistent with Section 36.122, Water Code, and may
10	regulate the terms on which a permit holder under those rules may
11	conduct such a transfer. [A retail public utility as defined by
12	Section 13.002, Water Code, is not required to obtain a permit to
13	transfer groundwater out of the district if:
14	[ <del>(1) the source of the water is one or more wells</del>
15	located within the district; and
16	[(2) the water is used by the retail public utility to
17	provide retail water utility service, as defined by Section 13.002,
18	Water Code.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
