## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the creation and authority of municipal development 3 districts. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subdivision (3), Section 377.001, Local Government 5 6 Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 "Development project" means: (3) (A) 8 [means: [(i)] a "project" as that term is defined by 9 Section 4B(a), Development Corporation Act of 1979 (Article 5190.6, 10 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes); or 11 12 (B) [and (ii)] a convention center facility or 13 related improvement such as a convention center, civic center, civic center building, civic center hotel, or auditorium, 14 including[; and 15 [(B) includes] parking areas or facilities that 16 are used to park vehicles and that are located at or in the vicinity 17 of other convention center facilities. 18 19 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 377, Local Government Code, is amended by adding Section 377.003 to read as follows: 20 Sec. 377.003. CONSTITUTIONAL PURPOSE. This chapter creates 21 22 a program under Section 52-a, Article III, Texas Constitution. 23 SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 377.021, Local 24 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

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(b) The order calling the election must:

2 (1) define the boundaries of the district to include 3 all or part of the <u>area contained in the</u> boundaries of the 4 municipality <u>and the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction</u>; 5 and

6 (2) call for the election to be held within those7 boundaries.

8 SECTION 4. Subsection (a), Section 377.022, Local 9 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

10 (a) A district is a political subdivision of this state and 11 of the municipality <u>that called the election creating</u> [<del>in which</del>] 12 the district [<del>is located</del>].

SECTION 5. Subsections (b) and (d), Section 377.051, Local Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

(b) The board is appointed by the governing body of the municipality <u>that called the election creating</u> [<del>in which</del>] the district [<del>is located</del>].

18 (d) To qualify to serve as a director, a person must be a resident of the municipality that called the election creating [in 19 which] the district or of that municipality's extraterritorial 20 jurisdiction [is located]. An employee, officer, or member of the 21 22 governing body of the municipality may serve as a director, but may not have a personal interest in a contract executed by the district 23 other than as an employee, officer, or member of the governing body 24 25 of the municipality.

26 SECTION 6. Section 377.053, Local Government Code, is 27 amended to read as follows:
