5	SECTION 1. Sections 22.01(c) and (e), Penal Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(c) An offense under Subsections (a)(2) or (3) is a Class C
8	misdemeanor, except that $\underline{\text{the}}$ [an] offense [under Subsection (a)(3)]
9	is <u>:</u>
10	(1) a Class A misdemeanor if the offense <u>is</u> [was]
11	committed under Subsection (a)(3) against an elderly individual or
12	disabled individual, as those terms are defined by Section 22.04;
13	<u>or</u>
14	(2) a Class A misdemeanor if the offense is committed
15	against a person the actor knows is a sports participant either:
16	(A) while the participant is performing duties or
17	responsibilities in the participant's capacity as a sports
18	participant; or
19	(B) in retaliation for or on account of the
20	participant's performance of a duty or responsibility within the
21	participant's capacity as a sports participant.

- 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 12 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 13 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 14 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 15 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
