## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the performance of the duties of a district attorney by 3 the prison prosecution unit in Trinity County. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 43.171, Government Code, is amended by 5 6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 7 (c) An attorney who is employed by the prison prosecution unit shall perform the duties of the district attorney if there is a 8 vacancy in the office of district attorney serving the county. The 9 attorney who is employed by the prison prosecution unit shall 10 perform the duties of district attorney only until the vacancy in 11 the county's office of district attorney is filled by the governor 12 13 or a district attorney is elected by the voters of the district. This subsection expires February 1, 2005. 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18

Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
