- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 6 amended by adding Article 11.65 to read as follows:
- Art. 11.65. BOND FOR CERTAIN APPLICANTS. (a) This article
 applies to an applicant for a writ of habeas corpus seeking relief
- 9 from the judgment in a criminal case, other than an applicant
- 10 seeking relief from a judgment imposing a penalty of death.
- (b) On making proposed findings of fact and conclusions of
- 12 law jointly stipulated to by the applicant and the state, or on
- 13 approving proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law made by
- 14 an attorney or magistrate appointed by the court to perform that
- duty and jointly stipulated to by the applicant and the state, the
- 16 convicting court may order the release of the applicant on bond,
- 17 subject to conditions imposed by the convicting court, until the
- 18 applicant is denied relief, remanded to custody, or ordered
- 19 released.
- 20 <u>(c) This article expires on the first anniversary of the</u>
- 21 date on which it became law.
- 22 SECTION 2. Article 11.65, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 23 added by this Act, applies to:
- 24 (1) any applicant who on or after the effective date of

- 1 this Act applies for a writ of habeas corpus; and
- 2 (2) any applicant whose application for a writ of
- 3 habeas corpus is pending on the effective date of this Act,
- 4 regardless of when the application was filed.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
