2 WHEREAS, The Federal Bureau of Investigation must be allowed
3 to maintain a physical presence in Juarez in order to assist in
4 solving these horrendous crimes; and

5 WHEREAS, Direct and personal involvement by Federal Bureau of
6 Investigation agents, especially in the collection of evidence, is
7 crucial to the expeditious solving of these murders; now,
8 therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas
10 hereby request that the Federal Bureau of Investigation be directly
11 involved in assisting the Mexican law enforcement authorities in
12 their investigation of the brutal murders of women in Juarez,
13 Mexico, in order to put an end to the violence and bring justice to
14 the families and friends of the victims; and, be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
16 copies of this resolution to the director of the Federal Bureau of
17 Investigation, the attorney general of the United States, the
18 United States secretary of state, and the president of the United
19 States.
