1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Texas is pleased to 2 recognize Herb Miller for winning five medals at the state 3 4 competition of the Senior Olympics held in Lubbock from August 26 to 5 September 1, 2002; and 6 WHEREAS, Herb Miller also participated in the regional senior 7 games from March 10 to March 16, 2002, in Temple, Texas, setting a golf scoring record of 68 and 70 for a total of 138, and he had the 8 first double eagle in Senior Olympics Games history; and 9 10 WHEREAS, The Senior Olympics Texas State Games are sanctioned 11 by the National Senior Games Association for athletes who are at least 50 years old; participants compete in 18 different sporting 12 13 events, including golf, discus, basketball, and track and field; 14 and 15 WHEREAS, Herb Miller won a gold medal in basketball, a silver medal in golf, a silver medal in the discus, a bronze medal in the 16 high jump, and a bronze medal in the shot put, and he qualified for 17 the national competition scheduled in Hampton Roads, Virginia, from 18 May 26 to June 9, 2003; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Herb enjoyed athletic competition in discus and shot put and in swimming and football in high school and college; he is a 21 22 graduate of Louisiana Tech University, where he was All-State in basketball, football, and track; and 23 24 WHEREAS, This exemplary athlete has participated in the

Senior Olympics for the past six years, sometimes competing against
 former high school and college rivals; he takes pleasure in
 watching athletes in their 80s and 90s take part in the games; and
