## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize an exemption or
- 2 other relief from ad valorem taxation for commercial tangible
- 3 personal property if the property is voluntarily rendered for
- 4 taxation.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 1, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:
- 8 (k) The Legislature may exempt from ad valorem taxation
- 9 \$10,000 or a lesser amount of the market value of tangible personal
- 10 property held or used for the production of income or provide other
- 11 tax relief if the property is voluntarily rendered for taxation.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize ad valorem
- 16 tax incentives to encourage the voluntary rendition of commercial
- 17 tangible personal property for taxation."
