A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to exempt from ad valorem
- 2 taxation certain commercial boats and equipment used for taking or
- 3 producing fish, shrimp, shellfish, or other marine life.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 19a, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 19a. (a) Implements of husbandry that are used in the
- 8 production of farm or ranch products are exempt from ad valorem
- 9 taxation.
- 10 (b) Boats and other equipment used primarily in the
- 11 <u>commercial taking or production of fi</u>sh, shrimp, shellfish, or
- 12 other marine life as food for human consumption are exempt from ad
- 13 valorem taxation. The legislature by general law may provide for
- 14 the administration of exemptions under this subsection and may
- 15 provide eligibility limitations for an exemption.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to provide the same
- 20 property tax treatment for boats and other equipment used in the
- 21 commercial taking or production of fish, shrimp, shellfish, or
- 22 other marine life as food as is provided by law for machinery and
- 23 equipment used for farm or ranch production."
