3	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
5	amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) The Legislature shall pass laws prohibiting lotteries
8	and gift enterprises in this State other than those authorized by
9	Subsections (b), (d), [and] (e) <u>, and (f)</u> of this section.
10	(f) The Legislature by general law may authorize and
11	regulate casino gaming conducted by the holder of a license or
12	permit issued by the State.
13	SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
14	submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
15	The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
16	proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing casino
17	gaming."
