## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to establish a public school

- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1, Article VII, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1. A general diffusion of knowledge being essential to
- 9 the preservation of the liberties and rights of the people, it shall
- 10 be the duty of the Legislature of the State to establish a [and make
- 11 suitable provision for the support and maintenance of an efficient]
- 12 system of public free schools, provide for the cost of classroom
- 13 teacher salaries and statewide teacher benefits, and provide
- 14 assistance to certain school districts, as determined by the
- 15 Legislature, for maintenance and construction of school
- 16 facilities.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 3(b), Article VII, Texas Constitution,
- 18 is repealed.
- 19 SECTION 3. The proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to establish a public
- 23 school finance system based on state provision of teacher salaries
- 24 and benefits and assistance for maintenance and construction of
