A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to permit a person to assume an office of a political subdivision
- 3 without an election if the person is the only candidate to qualify
- 4 in an election for that office.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by 7 adding Section 13A to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 13A. For an office of a political subdivision for which
- 9 this constitution requires an election, the legislature may provide
- 10 by general law for a person to assume the office without an election
- if the person is the only candidate to qualify in an election to be
- 12 held for that office.
- 13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 17 legislature to permit a person to assume an office of a political
- 18 subdivision without an election if the person is the only candidate
- 19 to qualify in an election for that office."
