## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to allow the repurchase of
- 2 real property acquired by a governmental entity through eminent
- 3 domain.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 52-c to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 52-c. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 8 constitution, a governmental entity may sell real property acquired
- 9 through eminent domain at the price the entity paid at the time of
- 10 acquisition if:
- 11 (1) the public use for which the property was
- originally acquired no longer exists; and
- 13 (2) the sale is made to the person who owned the real
- 14 property interest immediately before the governmental entity
- 15 acquired the property interest, or to the heirs of that person if
- the person is deceased.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to allow governmental
- 21 entities to sell property acquired through eminent domain back to
- 22 the previous owners at the price the entities paid to acquire the
- 23 property."
