1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 2 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing casino gaming.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding subsection (f) to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The Legislature shall pass laws prohibiting lotteries
- 8 and gift enterprises in this State other than those authorized by
- 9 Subsections (b), (d), [and] (e), and (f) of this section.
- 10 (f) The Legislature by general law may authorize and
- 11 regulate casino gaming conducted by the holder of a license or
- 12 permit issued by the State, at designated locations within the
- 13 state, with the states portion of tax revenue of such casino gaming
- 14 being dedicated to scholarships for Texas students that attend
- 15 Texas public colleges and universities.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing casino
- 20 gaming at designated locations in Texas, and using tax revenues to
- 21 provide for scholarships for Texas students that attend Texas
- 22 colleges and universities."
