WHEREAS, Granbury, the county seat, was founded in 1854; the Granbury Opera House, which dates back to the 1880s, and the Hood County Courthouse contribute to the historic ambience of the downtown area; residents proudly display the city's many cultural riches during the annual December candlelight tour, which includes such historic homes as Captain's House Bed and Breakfast, the Iron Horse Inn, the Dabney House, and the Pearl Street Inn; and
