WHEREAS, The Senate of the State of Texas is pleased to pay tribute to the Texas Transportation industry; and

WHEREAS, Transportation investment to ensure mobility throughout Texas is essential to the economic vitality of Texas and the quality of life of Texans; and

WHEREAS, The Texas Transportation Institute's 2002 Urban Mobility Report cites data illustrating alarming increases in congestion, delay, and cost pertinent to travel in Texas' major urban areas; and

WHEREAS, Highway safety, connectivity, and system reliability are issues important to citizens throughout Texas; and

WHEREAS, Texans interested in transportation and mobility have expressed a desire to designate a single day during the 78th Session of the Texas Legislature for focus on the importance of transportation and mobility in Texas; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 78th Legislature, hereby declare February 26, 2003, Texas Transportation Day at the State Capitol.
