**WHEREAS**, A devout Christian, Mrs. White was a cofounder of New Life Missionary Baptist Church and devoted her life to upholding three important institutions--home, church, and education; and

**WHEREAS**, In May of 2002, Mrs. White was honored by New Life Missionary Baptist Church for her dedicated service to the field of education and her many accomplishments in the community; the church proclaimed May 19, 2002, "Lunita White Day"; and

**WHEREAS**, A woman of integrity, strength, and generosity, Mrs. White gave unselfishly of her time to others, and her wisdom, warmth, and valued counsel will not be forgotten by those who knew her; and

**WHEREAS**, Lunita White lived her life to the fullest and was a devoted wife, mother, and grandmother, and she leaves behind memories that will be treasured forever by her family and many friends; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 78th Legislature, hereby extend sincere condolences to the family of Lunita Johnson White: her husband, Preston White; her children, Rodney, Tony, James, Kirk, Tonya, Darance, and Danzavier; and her 26 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren; and, be it further
