

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 935

**WHEREAS**, The Senate of the State of Texas is pleased to recognize Will Osborne, who won the University Interscholastic League Class 4A State Golf Tournament on May 6, 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, Playing at the Roy Kizer Golf Course in Austin, Will had pars on the first six holes before getting a birdie on the 414-yard, par-4 seventh hole; he then picked up two more pars to make the turn at 1-under; he started the back nine with a birdie on the 10th hole, followed by a string of five more pars before getting a birdie on the 16th hole, a par on the 17th hole, and the victory-clinching birdie on the 18th hole, and he finished one stroke ahead of his two opponents; and

**WHEREAS**, A Wichita Falls High School junior, Will became the first golfer from Wichita Falls to win the University Interscholastic League state golf championship; and

**WHEREAS**, Will Osborne played with determination and displayed great talent and perseverance throughout the tournament; he has brought credit to himself, his high school, and the City of Wichita Falls, and he deserves recognition for his exceptional accomplishment; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 78th Legislature, hereby commend Will Osborne for his superior skills as a golfer and extend congratulations to him on his state championship victory in the University Interscholastic League Class 4A State Golf Tournament; and, be it further
