R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 78th  
2 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, That Senate Rule 12.03 be  
3 suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08 to enable the  
4 conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on House  
5 Bill 3622, relating to the creation, administration, powers,  
6 duties, operation, and financing of the Kingsborough Municipal  
7 Utility District No. 1 of Kaufman County, to consider and take  
8 action on the following matter:

9 Senate Rules 12.03(1) and (3) are suspended to permit the  
10 committee to amend Section 15(a) of the bill to read as follows:

11 (a) This Act takes effect on the date on or after September  
12 1, 2003, on which a settlement agreement between the City of  
13 Crandall and the developer of the districts is legally executed  
14 regarding a pending petition before the Texas Commission on  
15 Environmental Quality for the right to provide retail water service  
16 to certain areas within the districts. If the settlement agreement  
17 is legally executed before September 1, 2003, this Act takes effect  
18 September 1, 2003.

19 Explanation: This change is necessary to ensure that the bill  
20 takes effect on a more appropriate date.
