**IN RE: HB54** by Wolens (Relating to certain early voting by mail procedures and to the prevention of voting fraud generally; providing criminal penalties.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill amends several sections of the Election Code relating to voter fraud. The Secretary of State indicates that passage of the bill would not have a significant fiscal impact to their agency.
