IN RE: HB54 by Wolens (Relating to certain early voting by mail procedures and to the prevention of voting fraud generally; providing criminal penalties.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill amends several sections of the Election Code relating to voter fraud. The Secretary of State indicates that passage of the bill would not have a significant fiscal impact to their agency.
