IN RE: HB227 by Keel (Relating to certain notice requirements in a court order providing for the possession of or access to a child.), **Committee Report 1st House, As Amended**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require that orders in suits that provide for the possession or access to a child contain a notice to peace officers. Additional statements would not significantly impact costs.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
