**IN RE: HB227** by Keel (Relating to certain notice requirements in a court order providing for the possession of or access to a child.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require that orders in suits that provide for the possession or access to a child contain a notice to peace officers. Additional statements would not significantly impact costs.
