**IN RE: HB281** by Moreno, Paul (Relating to an offense of using a telephone while operating a motor vehicle.), **As Introduced** 

# No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to make a person liable of committing an offense for using a telephone while operating a motor vehicle unless the vehicle is stopped or the telephone is used without use of either of the operator's hands.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2003.

# **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. Local government entities could expect to see a slight increase in fine revenue. The behavior outlawed by this bill only could be enforced by an officer directly observing the behavior.
