IN RE: HB296 by Goodman (Relating to petition requirements for an application for a place on the general primary election ballot for certain judicial candidates.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Election Code, Section 172.021 to require judicial candidates seeking a place on the general primary election ballot for an office on the Supreme Court or the Court of Criminal Appeals to meet petition requirements.
