IN RE: HB404 by Madden (Relating to the participation of a judge at a political party convention.),

Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Government Code, Chapter 33 relating to the participation of a judge at a political party convention. The bill would provide that a judge's participation at a political party convention could not be a basis for a finding of judicial misconduct under the Code of Judicial Conduct or any other law. The bill would apply to participation at a convention regardless of whether the State Commission on Judicial Conduct has commenced an investigation or formal proceeding before the effective date of the bill. The bill would take effect immediately if the bill receives the vote of two-thirds the members of each house. Otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2003.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
