**IN RE: HB406** by Miller (Relating to proceeds received by a person accused or convicted of a crime from publicizing the crime.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the forfeiture of contraband chapter of the Code of Criminal Procedure by adding telephone service, an electronic media format, including an Internet website, to the list of items listed as proceeds.
