**IN RE: HB672** by Madden (Relating to the compensation of a county chair who is not present at a central counting station.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

This bill would amend the Election Code to reduce by 15 percent the compensation paid to a county party chair for a primary election if that chair is not present at the central counting station for the entire time ballots are being counted.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
