IN RE: HB809 by Keel (Relating to certain gaming activity conducted by an Indian tribe or tribal organization.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Penal Code by preventing prosecution of various gambling offenses permitted under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act. The bill would apply to activity conducted on the premises of Indian tribes or tribal organizations recognized by the federal government. Subsequently, impact to the State would be insignificant.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
