**IN RE: HB861** by McReynolds (Relating to the qualifications of a volunteer emergency care attendant.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would prohibit the Department of Health from requiring a high school diploma or a high school equivalency certificate (GED) as a prerequisite for certification as an Emergency Care Attendant if the applicant certifies that he or she would only serve as a volunteer during the certification period.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
