**IN RE: HB913** by Goodman (Relating to the conservatorship of, and the possession of and access to, a child.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would make changes related to child custody and access such as a court may not contravene a jury verdict and questions that a court may not submit to a jury. The bill would largely impact private cases.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
