**IN RE: HB1060** by Thompson (Relating to prohibiting the promotion of certain improper photographs or visual recordings; providing a penalty.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Penal Code by including certain behavior in the offense of improper photography or visual recording. It is estimated that implementation of the bill would not have a significant impact on the costs of state or local government.
