**IN RE: HB1065** by Cook, Robby (Relating to the eligibility requirements to serve as a director of a groundwater conservation district.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Section 36.051, Water Code, to allow in a district with a population of less than 50,000 an officer or employee of a political subdivision to serve as a director of the water district and to allow a director of a water district to serve as a director, officer, or employee of a political subdivision. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2003.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
