**IN RE: HB1076** by McCall (relating to the ownership of a motor vehicle dealership. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The Texas Department of Transportation indicates it could absorb the costs of the bill within its current resources.

The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving a two-thirds majority vote in both houses; otherwise, the bill would take effect June 1, 2003.
