**IN RE: HB1148** by Miller (Relating to authorizing a temporary wind up permit for a concentrated animal feeding operation the permit for which has not been renewed or has been revoked.),  
**Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to issue a temporary concentrated animal feeding operation wind up permit to a person whose permit has not been renewed or has been revoked. The Commission reports that it has only revoked one concentrated animal feeding operation permit in the past five years.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
